**SPECIAL FALL HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION**

**Waukesha, (WI) –September 2, 2011** -There will be a special one-day collection of household hazardous waste Saturday, September 10 in Oconomowoc at the City Public Works Garage, 630 S. Worthington Street. Old, unusable chemicals, pesticides, wood preservatives, solvents, oil-based paints, and mercury-containing products will be accepted. Latex paint and non-hazardous cleaning materials will not be accepted.

This event will run from 8 a.m. until noon and is free to any county resident. Proof of residency is required.

In addition to household materials, this event will accept pesticides and chemicals from farms, greenhouses, and nurseries free. Farms and businesses must pre-register.
